JOB SUMMARY

Manage the daily activities of the maintenance department and all related tasks and functions in conjunction with overseeing the maintenance staff that includes general mechanics, electricians, purchasing agent, parts room clerk and wastewater personnel. In addition this position assists with supervision of the facility's anhydrous ammonia system, chlorine gas system and boilers.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Develops, schedules and controls a preventative maintenance program to maintain production machinery and equipment in proper and safe working condition. Develop, schedules and plans for building and grounds maintenance
- Ensure adherence to company policies, procedures, safety standards, facility rules and regulations and safety compliance
- Ensures all equipment and systems are operated within applicable Federal, State and local laws
- Work with Facility Manager and Human Resource Manager in the investigation of all work related injuries and illnesses and the
 preparation and submission of the supervisor's investigation report for all injuries/illnesses that involve personnel from the
 maintenance department
- Support DuPont STOP program and an environment that promotes zero accidents and an overall safety awareness culture
- Maintain and conduct employee annual authorized training
- Collaborate with Human Resources to maintain a training program of which supports professional development of the team
- Recommend and implement plans for facility continuous improvement
- Maintain and review completion of work orders and work requests from other departments through the EAM system
- Preparation, tracking and overall control of facility's repair and maintenance budget
- Maintain inventory of maintenance material, supplies and repair parts at pre-established and required levels
- Supervises and coordinates daily activities of maintenance department employees and establishes work schedules that support production activities that provide for timely repair and maintenance of facility buildings, grounds and equipment to established safety and health standards
- Inspection of work that is being performed to ensure that standards of workmanship and safety are maintained
- Recommends, plans and implements equipment needs through the capital budget process to improve production efficiency,
 safety and/or cost reduction
- Responsible for overall electrical and mechanical equipment layouts and the modification of all facilities within the building and grounds
- Establish accountability and the annual performance goals for the maintenance personnel that will be reviewed by the Plant
 Manager and HR Manager
- Provide oversight and supervision of the facility's wastewater system.
- Provide coverage and support to the Refrigeration Department, as necessary.
- Help to maintain the highest quality of finished product
