Provide leadership in associate training, and implementation and auditing of Quality Systems procedures, to ensure customer's expectations and food safety requirements are met.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Train graders, Sanitation employees, Quality Group Leads, all aspects of Quality systems and customer specifications.
- Manage time off, performance, reviews, counseling, engagement, and discipline among assigned Quality and Sanitation team members
- Manage relationships with chemical suppliers to maintain proper inventory levels and stay current with cleaning practices and technologies
- Reviews processing schedule and quality requirements to determine staffing requirements, work procedures, and duty assignments.
- Prepare and support facility audits, including SQF. Participation in audits as required, or in the Quality Systems Manager's absence.
- Assist in Customer and Regulatory tours and inspections as needed.
- With support from plant leadership, maintain SOPs and SSOPs for Quality and Sanitation
- Investigate as necessary holds and maintain documentation of releases.
- Manage facility held stock by completing product dispositions, getting Management input, when necessary
- Oversee critical record review and associated product release
- Identify and suggest process improvements for the Quality System and Quality Team
- Participate in the Food Safety Team
- Assist in training and auditing of the facility HACCP plan, Food Safety Plan, and quality system procedures.
- Participate in Internal Auditing, as assigned
- Oversee line sanitation inspections, train and delegate to graders
- Perform tasks of the Environmental Monitoring program, review results with Quality Systems Manager
- Evaluate Sanitary design flaws, review findings with the Quality Systems Manager and Maintenance Manager for remediation
- Preform microbiological investigations, vector sampling, and interpretation of results with the Quality Systems Manager
- Responsible for ensure the Master Sanitation Schedule is completed and accurately documented
- Assist in sampling as required due to holds and/or other product reviews.
- Communicate to Operations any nonconformance in personnel task completion, completion of critical records
- Communicate to Production and QS Managers when trends and issues are seen regarding bulk products or employee performance.
- Coach fellow associates regarding adherence to GMP's, GDP's, SOP's and quality system procedures.
- Communicates issues to Management and Group Leaders in a timely, professional manner.
- Complete other tasks as assigned by the Quality Systems Manager.
- Respond to customer complaints in the Quality Manager's absence
- Facility recall coordination in conjunction with, or in the absence of, the Quality Systems Manager
- Create and instill a positive work environment
- As part of a strong supervisory staff, responsible for the adherence and enforcement of facility policies, procedures and programs.
- Report any food safety, health & safety, or quality concerns to your immediate supervisor, (MANDATORY)
- Always works in a safe manner, Enforce and implement policies to establish a culture of health and safety.
